Thank you for your letter of the 15th inst. The girders will be supplied by us and hoisted and placed in position by our men - it is the preparation of the holes which has to be arranged for and these should be made plenty large enough, especially at the double depth end, so as to allow the girders to be manipulated into position and also to allow room for the space at the back of the girders to be solidly filled in.

It might be advisable to make a good "bed" by running some concrete to spread the bearing of the girder ends over any joints in the stonework but it is not necessary to provide anything to damp out vibration.
